**NOTICE FOR WRITTEN TEST FOR RECRUITMENT OF
ASSISTANTS (IN KVKs UNDER OUAT)**

As per Advt No. E-II-II-RC (T) 03/2012/2/2019/ 1354/UAT., Dated. 22.01.2019, the written test for the post of “Assistant” will be held at **11.00 A.M to 12 Noon on 03.09.2023 in different centres at Bhubaneswar.**

Instruction to the candidates for the written test:

1. The eligible candidates are to download the admit card from OUAT website: www.ouat.nic.in (Career at OUAT Section). The admit card will be available from **25.08.2023 onwards**. The candidate can download the admit card using the roll number/mobile phone number and date of birth. The list of eligible candidates will be available on OUAT website: www.ouat.nic.in (Career at OUAT Section) on **20.08.2023**.
2. No candidate will be allowed entry into Examination hall **without valid admit card and original Id proof** (Hard copy only, soft copy will not be accepted). Valid Id proofs are Aadhar Card with recent photo, PAN card, Driving license, Passport or Voter ID card.
3. The candidate is to paste a recent photograph on the admit card which will be verified with the photo id proof.
4. **The candidate must submit a copy of the admit card with photograph and photo copy of the photo id proof to invigilators at the examination hall.**
5. Candidates are advised to report at the Examination Venue on the date & time mentioned on the Admit Card. The candidates will be allowed entry into examination hall at 10.15 a.m for verification of authenticity of the candidates from the admit card and ID proof by the invigilators.
6. No candidate will be allowed entry after 10 minutes of commencement of examination.
7. **The examination will be of 75 marks comprising of General Knowledge (25 marks), General English (25 marks) and Quantitative Aptitude (25 marks). Each question carries 1 mark and there is no negative mark.**
8. The examination will be on pen and paper with MCQs. The candidates are to record their responses on OMR sheet. The candidate must read the instructions on the question booklets and OMR carefully before answering the questions.
9. **The candidate must return the question booklets and the OMR sheet to the invigilators at the end of the examination before leaving the examination hall.**
10. No Candidate shall be allowed to leave the examination hall before completion of the examination.
11. Any malpractice detected during the written examination will debar the candidate from the selection process.
12. Use of Books, Notebooks, Calculators, Watch Calculators, Pagers, Mobile Phone and all types of Electronic Gadget etc. are not permitted in the Examination Hall.

The shortlisted candidates after the written test will be called for a computer test of 25 marks, the date of which will be intimated later.
