9. Publication of the results of projects/activities/research in the journal or conference the scholar has to consult The Professor BPCL Biofuel Chair. All data collected by the scholar will be reported at the end of each month and will be kept with the Professor BPCL Biofuel Chair as well as with the Co-PI of the project.

If the research scholar quits his/her studies and discontinues before completion of his degree or forgoes the BPCL Scholarship due to some reason or he/she completes the degree successfully then the concerned Co-PIs will be responsible for collecting the research data from them so that the project work will not suffer.
11. The research scholar working with the BPCL Biofuel Scholarship will not avail any other scholarship during his/her his period of association with the BPCL Biofuel project.
