Weather Summary/Alert:

Angul district is likely to receive Clearly to Mainly cloudy sky in coming five days .The maximum temperature may range from 27-28°C. The minimum temperature may range 11-13°C. The wind will blow usually Easterly to South Easterly with a speed of 4-6 kmph up to Saturday. The maximum and minimum humidity is likely to remain in the range of 39-80% and 15-32% respectively. According to ERFS product Mainly dry weather very likely to prevail over the districts with Isolated dense fog during week-1 of Odisha during week-1 (5th to 11th January 2024). Mainly dry weather very likely to prevail over the districts Odisha during most of the days of week-2(12th to 18th January 2024) except isolated rainfall activity in some days over some districts of Odisha.

General Advisory:

In present weather conditions constant monitoring of timely sown onion crop against attack of thrips and infection of purple blotch should be done. Need based spraying of Diethane M -45 @ 3 grams per litre of water with sticky material (Tipol 1.0 gram /litre) are advised.

SMS Advisory:

Spraying of 2 % urea is advised for proper growth of pods in the pea crop.

Crop Specific Advisory:

	Morning foggy condition followed by sunny day with maximum temperature up to 30°C might result in aphid infestation. To manage aphids during primary stage of pest infestation spray Neem Based Pesticide (Azadirachtin) 1500 PPM @ 600 ml/acre. To manage Aphids chemically spray Thiamethoxam 25% W.G @ 40 gram/acre or Acetamiprid 20% S.P. @ 50 gram/acre or Imidacloprid 17.8% SL @ 60-ml/acre by mixing in 200 litres of water.

Horticulture Specific Advisory:

MANGO	Irrigation at regular Interval after flower appearance. If Foggy or cloudy weather prevails spray the mango plant with wettable Sulphur 3gm/L. After appearance of flower always spray the crop at afternoon and evening hour as most of the pollinators are active in the mango orchard in the morning hour.
