### Weather Summary/Alert:

Angul district is likely to receive very light rainfall Wednesday, Thursday, Saturday with Mainly to Partly cloudy sky in coming five days .The maximum temperature may range from 27-28°C. The minimum temperature may range 13-15°C. The wind will blow usually South Easterly with a speed of 6-7 kmph up to Saturday. The maximum and minimum humidity is likely to remain in the range of 77-98% and 32-59% respectively. According to ERFS product Mainly dry weather very likely to prevail over the districts of Odisha except isolated rainfall activity in some districts of Odisha towards end of week-1(12th to 18th January 2024). ### General Advisory:

Don't go for application of any sort of insecticide on Wednesday, Thursday, Saturday as district is likely to experience very light rainfall .

### SMS Advisory:

Angul district is likely to experience very light rainfall on Wednesday, Thursday, Saturday. Ensure the safe storage of harvested rice.

### Crop Specific Advisory:

BLACK GRAM	The rainfall in this week may aggravate powdery mildew disease. To control Powdery mildew in green gram, Remove the infested leaves when the disease first appear. Go for application of Sulphur 80% WP @ 800 gm per acre is recommended in 200 litres of water when the sky is clear after Saturday.

### Horticulture Specific Advisory:

Menacinakahi	Due to the ongoing foggy weather condition, sucking pest might infest chilli crop. For management of leaf curl disease and sucking pest (Aphid , Thrips) in chilli, Spray Imidachloprid 5ml/15 litre of water when the sky is clear after Saturday.

**Fisheries Specific Advisory:**

COMMON FISH	Maintain at least a 6 ft. height for better hibernation due cold season. Application of CIFAX @ 1000ml per ha/m water spread area to control Epizootic Ulcerative Syndrome disease in Fish. Application of supplementary feed @ 2% of total fish mass body weight at 2 pm in fish culture pond.

**Poultry Specific Advisory:**

CHICKEN	Water should be given at ambient temperature at 2 times feed intake. Feed to water ratio should be maintained at 1:5 as against 1:2 during winter.

GENERAL ADVICE	The district is likely to experience light rain on Wednesday, Thursday, Saturday along with isolated dense fog. Cover the crop during early morning and after evening hour.
