#### Weather Summary/Alert:

Angul district is likely to receive light rainfall with clear to generally cloudy sky, maximum temperature is may range 33-35°C up to Tuesday. The minimum temperature may range 16-18°C The wind will blow usually Easterly to South Eastly with a speed of 7-13 kmph up to Tuesday. The maximum and minimum humidity is likely to remain in the range of 61-96 % and 20-39 % respectively.

### **General Advisory:**

In case of pest infestation n stored grain of rice, apply Three Aluminum Phosphide Tablet per one ton of rice, Cover it well with Tarpaulin and ensure no space is left. Farmers must ensure to cover all corner and door space with Tarpaulin and cello tape so that no gas will escape the room.

### **SMS Advisory:**

The district is going to experience isolated thunderstorm on Saturday, Donot let cattle graze outside.

### **Crop Specific Advisory:**

BLACK GRAM	Black gram crop is likely to be infested by Powdery Mildew due to foggy weather, go for foliar application of Sulphur 80% WP /Litre of water. ( Do not application of pesticide as a little rainfall is expected.)		
GREEN GRAM	There are chances of infestation of Greengram crops by the yellow mosaic virus. To manage the population of the vector in the field first get rid of the severely infected plants by uprooting and destroying them far away from the field. Install 20 yellow sticky traps per acre. To manage whiteflies chemically spray Thiamethoxam @ 40 gram/acre or Acetamiprid @ 50-gram /acre or Pyriproxifen 10% EC @ 200-ml/acre by mixing in 200-litre of water.( Do not application of pesticide as a little rainfall is expected.)		

### **Poultry Specific Advisory:**

CHICKEN	During summer season, avoid feeding at high environment temperature in the mid-day. Birds should be fed in morning and evening time. Cleaning and spreading of bleaching powder at every alternate day is highly essential for a poultry unit.
