Forecast up to 20.03.2024 (According to MC, IMD, Bhubaneswar)

- > Chances of partly cloudy to overcast sky during next five days.
- > During next five days, chances of very light to light rainfall.
- Maximum temperature is expected to be 28-33°C and minimum temperature is expected to be 14-16°C.
- Maximum and minimum relative humidity is expected to be 60-81%, and 18-34%, respectively.

Agromet Advisory

General:

- ➤ Apply well decomposed Farm Yard Manure/ vermicompost during last ploughing in the field.
- ➤ Before raising any crop go for collection of soil sample and test it in nearby soil testing laboratory.
- > Apply balanced fertilizers in all the crops as per soil test based recommendations mentioned in the soil health card.

Rice:

- ➤ Due to rise in temperature, the attack of stem borer has aggravated in rice. Three pheromone traps/acre may be installed in the rice field, whenever the number of male moths/trap reaches 4-5/day, spray Chlorantraniliprole 18.5% SC @ 0.3 ml/litre of water or Fipronil 5% SC @ 2 ml/litre of water.
- ➤ Bacterial leaf blight may reported in rice field, spray Plantomycin @ 1 g + Copper oxychloride 50% WP @ 3 g/litre of water. If necessary repeat at 15 days later.

Groundnut:

➤ Increase in temperature may enhance red hairy caterpillar and tobacco caterpillar infestation in groundnut, to control these spray Profenophos 50% EC @ 2 ml/litre of water or Flubendiamide 480 SC @ 0.2 ml/litre of water.

Pulses:

➤ To control vector of YMV in green gram spray Imidacloprid 17.8% SL @ 0.3 ml/litre of water or Acetamiprid 20% SP @ 0.3 g/litre of water.

Onion

➤ Prepare main field to transplant onion seedlings at eight week stage. Apply FYM 2ton, DAP 43kg, urea 27kg, MOP 33kg and Sulphur 20kg for one acre area transplanting.

Vegetables:

- ➤ White fly infestation may occur at this stage of tomato, to control it spray Imidacloprid 17.8% SL @ 0.3 ml/litre of water or Thiomethaxome 25% WG @ 0.4 g/litre of water.
- > To control fruit and shoot borer in brinjal spray Spinosad 45% SC @ 70 ml/acre and Thiodicarb 75% WP @ 250 g/acre at 15 days interval.

Mango:

- ➤ Chances of mango hopper infestation in present situation, to control it spray Buprofezin 25% SC @ 1-2 ml/litre of water or Imidacloprid 17.8% SL @ 0.3 ml/litre of water.
- > Spray Alpha Napthyl Acetic Acid 4.5% SL (Planofix) @ 4.5 ml in 10 litre of water when tender fruits are in pea size and go for second spray when fruits are in marble size.
