Weather Summary/Alert:

According to the weather forecast received from India Meteorological Department, the district is likely to receive very light to light rain up to Saturday with partly to generally cloudy sky. The wind speed is likely to remain within 05.0 to 07.0 kmph for the next five days. The daily maximum and minimum temperature may range from 38.0°C to 39.0°C and 25.0°C to 27.0°C respectively. Relative humidity during the morning and the afternoon may range between 56 to 73 percent and 20 to 26 percent respectively.

General Advisory:

The mean maximum daily temperature was 39.7°C and the mean minimum daily temperature was 24.1°C of the Gajapati district during the last week. The district received 05.0 mm of rainfall during the last week. Farmers are advised to make bund for conserving rain water in the paddy field. Bund should be higher and wider so that more rain water can be conserved in the field. Drain out excess water from vegetable nursery and non paddy field by keeping drain ends open. Withheld sowing, spraying of pesticide and irrigation activities for some days. There are chances of incidence of both fungal and bacterial diseases like leaf blight, wilt, and rot in different standing crops. To manage these diseases, spray Metalaxyl+ Mancozeb @ 2g/litre of water or Carbendazim+ Mancozeb @ 2gr/litre of water along with Plantomycin @ 1g/ litre of water. Protect the mangoes in trees by netting from hail storm and heavy wind.

SMS Advisory:

In view of forecasted thunderstorm accompanied with gusty winds, provide mechanical support to cucurbits.
