IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Please go through the prospectus carefully. The applicant has to submit online application form through website <https://ouat.ac.in> (Academic Section > Admission Section > Candidate Login) or <https://ouat-lokaseba-odisha.in> through candidate login. Candidate has to login providing e-mail, mobile number and OTP to submit the application form. The candidate has to login to edit application form, download acknowledgement of application form, entrance mark, weightage & rank card, intimation letter, etc. will be available through a link using the application number and date of birth.

The entrance examination for Masters' programme will be held online in Computer Based Test (CBT) mode and the entrance test for Doctoral Programme (Ph.D.) will be held in off line mode. To appear the online entrance examination, the candidate must have the admit card (Hard copy only) and original ID proof (As per clause No. 6.1.2 of P.G. prospectus-2026-27). No hard copy of application Form and documents will be accepted.

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PROSPECTUS FOR THE SESSION, 2026-27

1. ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

The Odisha University of Agriculture and Technology (OUAT) is a State Agricultural University which established in the year 1962 in accordance with the provision of the Orissa Act 20 of 1961. It has triple mandate of teaching, research and extension.

The University offers education at the undergraduate and post-graduate level in Agriculture, Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry, Agricultural Engineering & Technology, Fishery Science, Community Science, Forestry and Basic Science & Humanities. The University also offers education in Computer Science and Application, Bioinformatics and Agri Business Management at Post Graduate level under self finance scheme at Centre of Post Graduate Studies (CPGS). Research and Extension programmes are carried out at all agro climatic zones of the state comprising of the Regional Research and Technology Transfer Stations (RRTTS), Sub-Stations of RRTTS, All India Co-ordinated Research Projects (AICRPs) and KrishiVigyan Kendra (KVKs) located in different parts of Odisha.

Masters' programmes are offered in 16 disciplines in Agriculture, 15 disciplines in Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry, three disciplines in Agricultural Engineering & Technology, one discipline in Fishery Science, one discipline in Community Science, four disciplines in Forestry Science. Doctoral programmes with Course Credit System are available in fifteen disciplines in Agriculture, twelve disciplines in Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry, three disciplines in Agril. Engineering and one discipline in Fishery Science.

Besides, Masters' programmes in seven disciplines and Doctoral programmes in six disciplines are also offered in the College of Basic Science & Humanities (CBSH). Admission for CPGS and CBSH are held separately.

2. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

- Only four year Bachelor Degree Programme in Agriculture and Allied Sciences and five & half years in B.V.Sc. & AH and Masters' Programme in concerned subject are eligible for admission into Doctoral Programme.

2.2. Marks in qualifying examination

2.2.1 For Masters' Programme:

Candidate must have passed 4 years Bachelor degree examination as mentioned at 2.1.1 securing an Overall Grade Point Average (OGPA) of at least 6.60/10.00 in ten point scale, 3.25/5.00 in five point scale and 2.60/4.00 in four point scale for General Category, whereas for SC/ST/Person With Disability (PWD)/ Kashmiri Migrant/ Kashmiri Pandit (Non-Migrants) / Kashmiri Hindu Families (Non-Migrants) candidates, the said requirement is OGPA of at least 5.60/10.00, 2.75/ 5.00 and 2.20/4.00, respectively. In other cases, where marks are awarded instead of grade points, the candidates must have secured at least 60% marks for General Category, for SC/ST/PWD/ Kashmiri Migrant/ Kashmiri Pandit (Non-Migrants) / Kashmiri Hindu Families (Non-Migrants) categories, the requirement is 50% marks. (Please note that equivalence between OGPA and % marks will not be acceptable)

2.2.2 For Doctoral Programme:

A candidate must have secured OGPA of 7.00 in 10-point scale or 65% marks in Masters' Degree as mentioned at 2.1.2.

2.2.3 The university will not verify the OGPA/marks in the qualifying examinations submitted by the candidates (Masters' & Doctoral Programme) for eligibility in the online application form. Any candidate found ineligible at the time of counselling and admission as per clause 2.2 will be deprived from admission.

2.2.4 The University will not be responsible for any wrong/incorrect information furnished by the candidate in his/her online application form and no communication will be made by the University in this regard. Candidates are advised to submit correct marks and other details.

2.2.5 The requirement of minimum percentage of marks / OGPA /GPA as indicated at clause 2.2.1 and 2.2.2 both in Masters' and Doctoral Programmes, respectively, shall not be applicable to State Government sponsored candidates and foreign candidates sponsored by ICAR/ICCR/any other statutory bodies of Govt. of India. However, the minimum qualification for Masters' programme will be Graduation (4 years) in concerned discipline, and for Ph. D. Programme, Graduation and Masters' degree in concerned discipline are essential.

2.3. Eligibility criteria

2.3.1. Domicile requirements:

- i) Those who have passed H.S.C./Equivalent Examination with Odia as M.I.L. from any school/ institution of Odisha. There is no need to submit the Residential Certificate for these candidates.
- ii) Those who do not have Odia as M .I. L., but whose parents are permanent residents of Odisha must furnish evidence of such permanent residency in the form of a certificate from the Revenue Officer concerned not below the rank of Tahasildar /Addl. Tahasildar/District Magistrate / their employer concerned.
- iii) Those who do not have Odia as M.I.L and whose parents are not permanent residents of Odisha, but serving under the Govt. of Odisha/Central Govt. /Public Undertaking or any University in the State of Odisha, such candidate must furnish a certificate to this effect from the Head of the Office /Institution where his/her parent(s) is/are working.
- iv) Odia candidates permanently residing outside Odisha must furnish a certificate in support of their Odisha origin either from their Employer (as per Clause 2.2 (iii)) / Tahasildar or Addl. Tahasildar / District Magistrate of the District in which he/she is residing. Certificate to this effect can also be submitted from the Tahasildar or Addl. Tahasildar / District Magistrate of their native place of Odisha.

No affidavit for the above categories shall be entertained.

- (v) The above provisions, i.e. 2.3.1 (i) to (iv), are **not** applicable to ICAR/VCI/Foreign Candidates/State Govt. sponsored candidates/children of employees of O.U.A.T/ J&K candidates under Prime Minister's Special Scholarship Scheme (PMSSS) / candidates under Kashmiri Migrants/Kashmiri Pandit (Non-Migrants) / Kashmiri Hindu Families (Non-Migrants) categories.

2.3.2 In-service candidates who are not sponsored by State Govt./ Central Govt./ other agencies must furnish an undertaking during online submission of application to submit permission letter / NOC from their competent authority at the time of admission, failing which the admission will be denied.

N.B: The domicile certificate as relevant to the candidate must be produced at the time of counselling and admission; failing which admission will be denied.

- 3.1.1 The university reserves the right to change the number of seats if required. Latest rule and regulation in any matter of admission, specified by competent authority will be followed during the admission process.
- 3.1.2. When there is one seat for both SC & ST candidates, the seats are allotted on alternate basis every year as specified in the prospectus.
- 3.1.3 The seats reserved for SC & ST candidates separately are not interchangeable.
- 3.1.4 **Candidate seeking admission on cost sharing seats shall pay Rs.32,000/- per annum extra in addition to the fees mentioned under clause-13. (Also refer to clause 16)**
- 3.1.5 The seats under EWS category (@ 10% of total ICAR seats) has to be given separately and mandatorily and these seats will be over and above the total ICAR seats.

* State seat of Ph.D. in Veterinary Science is temporarily frozen. In the event of selection of state candidate into the Ph.D. Programme, the admission will be allowed in vacant ICAR seats irrespective of the departments. If all seats of ICAR are filled up, then seats will be released according to number of candidates found eligible for admission in Doctoral Programme limited to one in each department.

In pursuance of O.O. No. ACD-III-MISC-0039-2024- 7003/UAT dtd. 23.04.2025 of Registrar, OUAT, Bhubaneswar, two seats in Agricultural Meteorology, College of Agriculture, Bhubaneswar in Ph.D. Programme shall function from the Academic Year 2025-26.

In pursuance of O.O. No. ACD-III-MISC-0026-25/ 20678/UAT dtd. 27.11.2025 of Registrar, OUAT, Bhubaneswar, three seats in Silviculture and Agroforestry, College of Forestry, Bhubaneswar in Ph.D Programme shall function from the Academic session 2026-27.

4. RESERVATION

4.1 Eight per cent (8%) and twelve per cent (12%) of seats excluding ICAR seats are reserved for SC and ST candidates, respectively, in each department.

Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe persons, who have migrated from their state of origin to another state for the purpose of seeking education, employment etc., will be deemed to be scheduled caste/tribe of the state of their origin and will be entitled to derive benefits from the state of origin and not from the state to which they have migrated (Vide Govt. of India Letter No. B.C.-16014/1/82-S.C. & B.C.D.-1 dated 22nd Feb, 1985).

Five per cent (5%) seats are reserved for Person with Disability (PwD) candidates out of the total number of seats available faculty wise (excluding ICAR seats), subject to maximum one in each department in Masters' program. The seats for PwD candidates will be filled up from unreserved seats under general category seats shown in the seat break up at 3.1. The PwD certificate obtained from the competent authority should have clear mention of percentage of disability and it should be minimum 40%. In case of temporary disability, the certificate should have mention about the disability review period. After the review period, a fresh certificate has to be obtained and produced at the time of counselling and admission, failing which his/her admission to the PwD category seat will be denied.

The candidate has to submit a declaration in the online application form to produce the relevant documents as per the category claimed at the time of counselling and admission, failing which the candidate will be debarred from admission in that category.

For B.Sc. (Hort.) students, one seat in each of the Vegetable Science, Fruit Science and Floriculture & Landscaping course programme will be kept reserved from the unreserved seats and will be admitted from the separate merit list for horticulture students. Rest of the seats will be filled up through open competition following common general merit list as per clause at 7.3.

4.1.1 FOR STATE GOVT. SPONSORED STUDY LEAVE IN-SERVICE CANDIDATES

The state Govt. In-service candidates sponsored on study leave are allowed to take admission into different Post Graduate and Doctoral Programmes only in University counselling process on the basis of merit list prepared from Entrance Examination -2026.

4.2 Seats over and above the intake capacity:

4.2.1 For State Govt. sponsored in-service candidates.

- (a) Two seats in each Department of M. V. Sc. and one seat in each Department of Ph.D. in Veterinary Science.
- (b) Two seats in M.Sc. (Community Science).
- (c) Two seats for M.F.Sc. in Aquaculture and one seat in Ph.D. Aquaculture.
- (d) Two seats in each Department of M.Sc.(Agriculture) and one seat in each Department of Ph.D. in Agriculture.
- (e) Two seats in each department of M. Tech.(Agril. Engg.) and one seat in each Department of Ph.D. Agril. Engg..
- (f) Two seats in each department of M.Sc. (Forestry)

4.2.2 For Kashmir migrants/Kashmir Hindus/Kashmir Pandits

One seat kept for wards of the Kashmiri migrants, in each college for Masters' Programme only. Similarly, one seat kept for Kashmiri Pandit (Non-Migrants) / Kashmiri Hindu Families (Non-Migrants) in each college for Masters' Programme only. The candidates have to produce the certificate

from competent authority for being a Kashmiri Migrant/ Kashmiri Pandit (Non-Migrants) / Kashmiri Hindu Families (Non-Migrants). (Also refer to clause 6.6 (vi & vii) of P.G. Prospectus-2026). **Kashmiri Migrant candidates have to produce the migrant certificate from Relief and Rehabilitation Commissioner (M), Jammu, Govt. of Jammu & Kashmir).**

4.2.3 For students from other States of India

One seat is kept for outside state students for admission into Masters' and Ph. D. Programme in each discipline over and above the normal seat on cost sharing basis, subject to qualifying in P.G. Entrance Examination. **The merit of the other state candidates will be on the basis of the score in the entrance examination only. The candidates are to produce domicile certificates of their respective states from the revenue officer not below the rank of Addl Tahasildar/ Tahasildar.** Also refer to clauses 6.6 (v) and 16. **If the seats remain vacant, these seats shall not be filled up by any other category and not through spot admission also.**

4.2.4 Foreign candidates sponsored by ICAR/ICCR

One seat in each subject/discipline of Masters' and Doctoral programme is reserved for foreign candidates sponsored by ICAR/ICCR/any other statutory bodies of Govt. of India. If the seats remain vacant, those seats shall not be filled up by any other categories.

In case of foreign candidates sponsored by the ICAR/ICCR/any other statutory bodies of Govt. of India, the deficient courses as decided by the advisor will have to be taken as remedial or prerequisite courses.

4.2.5 NRI/PIO Sponsored Seats

Two seats in each P.G. Department for Masters' Programme will be available under NRI/PIO sponsored category on cost sharing basis **(fees as applicable to NRI/PIO sponsored candidates).** For details refer to clause 6.7.

N.B:

- 1. State Govt. sponsored in-service candidates for admission into seats mentioned at 4.2.1 (a to f) must report for admission with sponsorship letter from State Govt. on the due date of admission mentioned in the prospectus or changes as and when notified, failing which the admission for the particular academic year will not be entertained.**
- 2. The over and above seats mentioned at clause 4.2 if remain vacant will not be filled up by any other categories and not through spot admission also.**

4.2.6 OUAT SPONSORED IN-SERVICE PROGRAMME

Faculty members of OUAT may be allowed to take admission in Ph.D Programme in accordance with O.O. No. 946/UAT dtd. 20.01.2026 of the Registrar, OUAT.

5. HOW TO GET PROSPECTUS

The candidates desirous of admission into Masters'/Doctoral programme for Agril. and Allied Sciences may visit OUAT Website "<https://ouat.ac.in>" (Academic Section > Admission Section) with effect from **25.05.2026** to get the prospectus.

6. HOW TO APPLY

6.1 How to apply

The candidates seeking admission into Masters'/ Doctoral Programmes – 2026 in Agriculture and Allied Sciences (except M.V.Sc.) can apply online **between 05.06.2026 to 29.06.2026** by visiting the OUAT website www.ouat.ac.in (Academic Section > Admission Section > Candidate Login) and click on "Student login for online application for Post Graduate Programme-2026 (Agril. & Allied Sciences)" or directly go to <https://ouat-lokaseba-odisha.in>. **The last date for payment of application fee is 30.06.2026.** For admission into M.V.Sc. Programme can apply online between 18.09.2026 to 07.10.2026 and the last date of payment of application fee is 08.10.2026.

The candidates must login with correct e-mail ID, mobile number. Two different OTPs will be sent separately to e-mail ID and mobile number separately which the candidate will use along with captcha for first time login to submit the application Form-A.

For subsequent login to submit final OGPA/Marks of the qualifying examination, edit application Form, download application Form, only one OTP will be sent to both the registered mobile number and e-mail ID. The candidate can use the OTP either from mobile number or from e-mail ID.

After login, the candidate will land on a window showing “Apply”, clicking on “Post Graduate Programme-2026 (Agril. & Allied Sciences)” the application Form will appear and the candidate will fill up the application. At the time of submission of online application form, the candidate has to fill in the particulars such as personal information etc. and upload his/her recent passport size colour photograph (Height:200px,width:150px, file size: 200kb maximum), full signature (Height: 100px, width: 150px, file size: 200kb maximum) in jpg/jpeg format.

The candidates must ensure proper uploading of photo and signature in the application form.

The candidates are to fill all star (*) marked fields (mandatory fields) mentioned in the online form, failing which the application will not be submitted. The candidate must give a self declaration in the application (by marking (√) in the self declaration boxes for relevant documents) that he/she will produce the relevant documents in original at the time of counselling and admission, failing which the candidature will be rejected. The candidate must mark (√) on the declaration check box, accepting that all information submitted are true and will be responsible for any false or misleading information. Before submitting, the candidate can have a preview of the application and make correction, if required. After submission of online application Form, an application number will be generated and sent to his/her mobile number & e-mail.

6.1.1 Application Fees

The candidate has to pay Rs. 2000.00 (Rupees two thousand only) as application fees to the University besides bank charges as specified by the Bank depending upon the mode of payment selected through online payment gateway using internet Banking/Debit Card/Credit Card. Once candidate successfully pays the fee, he/she will receive a message confirming the acceptance of application in mobile phone and e-mail. Fees, once paid, cannot be refunded under any circumstances. Without receipt of application fee, the Application Form will be rejected. **If the online payment is failed, then the candidate must make the payment again.** If the money has been deducted from the account in the previous attempt (in case of the failed transaction), that will be reverted to the source account within 8 working days.

Application is editable till the last date of submission of application. However, the candidate can log in to enter the final OGPA/marks of the qualifying examination till 28.07.2026 for all Masters’ Programme and all Ph.D. Programme except Veterinary Science and 25.11.2026 for all M.V.Sc. programme. Candidates must enter correct final OGPA/marks in academic profile section of the application form. (Please refer to Clauses 6.3 and 7.3 of P.G. Prospectus for details).

For details, please refer to Annexure-I.

Registered mobile number and e-mail are always required to access his/her profile each time with OTP sent to mobile number and e-mail. The candidates are advised to use his/her application number for subsequent access.

6.1.2 Download of Admit Card

The entrance examination will be held in CBT mode for Masters' programme and the entrance examination for doctoral programme (Ph. D) will be held in off line mode on **18.07.2026** and for M.V.Sc. will be held on **08.11.2026** and **the admit card will be available from 10.07.2026 and 03.11.2026, respectively. The examination will be held in Bhubaneswar only.** The Admit Card can be downloaded from OUAT website (<https://ouat.ac.in>). The candidate must bring the Admit card with original identity proof to the Examination Centre for verification. Without admit card and original ID proof, the candidate will not be allowed into the examination hall and hence, will be debarred from appearing the entrance examination.

Documents for Identification proof

- (ii) Driving License
- (iii) PAN Card
- (iv) Passport
- (v) Aadhaar Card (with recent photograph)

The candidates are advised not to send any hard copy of the application and documents to the University.

6.2 A candidate is required to submit only one online application irrespective of the number of subjects (in a particular discipline like M.Sc. (Agriculture)/ Ph.D. (Agriculture)/ M.Tech. (Agril. Engineering) or Ph.D. (Agril. Engineering), etc., for which he/she wishes to be considered indicating the final OGPA / Percentage of marks secured in the qualifying degree examination.

6.3 **Candidates are advised to enter correct final OGPA/marks in the application form under academic profile. In case of tie, any wrong entry of final OGPA/mark, detected at the time counselling and admission, the candidate will be placed at the lowest rank in the group of candidates having same weightage. Also refer to Clause 7.3 of P.G. Prospectus-2026.**

6.4 Foreign candidates sponsored by ICAR/ICCR/any other statutory bodies of Govt. of India with scholarship, have to apply either through ICAR/ICCR/any other statutory bodies of Govt. of India, New Delhi or through the Indian Embassy in their country for consideration of their case or through study in India portal.

6.5 The ICAR/ Foreign candidates sponsored by ICAR/ICCR/any other statutory bodies of Govt. of India/State Govt. selected against the reserve seats are required to pay the application fee and fill up the prescribed form at the time of admission.

6.6 **Candidates will submit a declaration at the time of submission of online application that he/she will produce the relevant documents in original from competent authority at the time of counselling and admission failing which the admission will be denied. The relevant documents to be produced by the candidates are as follows:**

- i) SC/ST Certificate from Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tahasildar/Additional Tahasildar in case of claim with **clear-cut indications of SC/ST category.** (Clause 4.1 of P.G. Prospectus-2026)**
- ii) The candidates applying under PwD category shall have to produce the original PwD certificate issued from competent authority (**Notification No. S.R.O. No. 518/2012 dtd. 22.06.2012 of Principal Secretary to Govt., Department of Women & Child Development, Govt. of Odisha**). (Clause 4.1 of P.G. Prospectus-2026-27.)**
- iii) In case of candidates not having Odia as MIL in HSC or its equivalent, certificate of permanent residence of parents in Odisha as relevant in individual cases from the competent authority. (Clause 2.3.1 of P.G. Prospectus-2026-27.)**

OR

iv) Copy of certificate from the District Magistrate of the concerned district in case of Odia permanently residing outside Odisha, who did not have Odia as M.I.L in H.S.C./ Equivalent examination. (Clause 2.3.1 of P.G. Prospectus-2026-27.)

OR

v) Service Certificate (original/attested copy) of parent(s) from the Head of the Office/Institution as relevant in individual cases. (Clause 2.3.1 of P.G. Prospectus-2026-27.)

vi) **Other state candidates need to produce the domicile certificate from their respective states from a revenue officer not below the rank of Addl. Tahasildar/ Tahasildar.** (Clause 4.2.3 of P.G. Prospectus-2026-27.)

vii) Relevant documents with respect to claim for weightage on extracurricular activities as per Clause 7.5 of P.G. Prospectus-2026-27. **The candidate has to upload the scanned copy of the documents along with the application and also produce the original documents at the time of counselling and admission.**

viii) Certificate from competent authority for being a migrant of Kashmir to claim under Kashmiri Migrant quota. (Clause 4.2.2 of P.G. Prospectus-2026-27.)

ix) Certificate from competent authority for being Kashmiri Pandit (Non-Migrants)/ Kashmiri Hindu Families (Non-Migrants) to claim the said quota (Clause 4.2.2 of P.G. Prospectus 2026-27.)

6.7 CANDIDATES SEEKING ADMISSION UNDER NRI/ PIO SPONSORED QUOTA

Candidates seeking admission under NRI/PIO Sponsored Quota must fulfill the guidelines under Clause-2 and shall be required to produce the following documents at the time of counselling and admission, failing which his/her admission to the category seat will be denied.

1. Photo copies of VISA/Proof of permanent residential certificate
2. Passport of the sponsor (Parents/ relatives) valid till the last date of admission
3. Recent residential proof (within last six months) of NRI/PIO sponsor such as electric bill/telephone bill/water bill etc. of the respective country
4. Sponsorship certificate (Annexure- III).

The signature of the NRI/PIO sponsoring person must be same as in the passport and sponsoring certificate otherwise the claim under NRI/PIO sponsored category will be rejected. Copy of VISA/Proof of permanent residential certificate, PASSPORT and residential proof etc should be in English version issued by competent authority from respective embassy/ consulate. Those who submit online VISA (downloaded from internet) should ensure that it is countersigned by the embassy with entry records.

An NRI/PIO can sponsor only one candidate in an academic year. The sponsor should be first degree blood relative of the candidate with exact mention of the relation in the Sponsorship Form at **Annexure– III** supported by a document from Govt. agency or an affidavit from the Executive Magistrate.

Blood relation of NRI/PIO with the candidate is defined as per the court order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case W.P.(C) No. 689/2017- Consortium of Deemed University in Karnataka (CODEUNIK) & Ans. Vs Union of India & Ors. Dated 22.08.2017.

The person with blood relation should ordinarily be residing abroad and must provide the proof of any of the following :

- Real brother and sister of father i.e. real uncle and real aunt.
- Real brother and sister of mother i.e. real maternal uncle and maternal aunt.
- Father and mother of father i.e. grandfather and grandmother.
- Father and mother of mother i.e. maternal grandfather and maternal grandmother.
- First degree - paternal and maternal cousins. (The children of the parents siblings)

6.7.1 Candidates seeking admission into NRI/PIO sponsored seats shall pay Rs. 2,05,000/- per annum extra in addition to the fees mentioned under Clause-13. (Also refer to clause 16)

7. SELECTION OF CANDIDATES

- 7.1 The Admission Board will monitor and conduct the admission process.
- 7.2 The selection for admission into different Masters' or Doctoral programme will be based on merit of the candidates. There will be a common merit list for admission in to Masters' Programme of a particular faculty. The merit list for admission into Doctoral Programme will be prepared discipline wise and selection will be made on the basis of merit.
- 7.3 Merit list of the candidates for Masters' programme shall be drawn up on the basis of total weightage derived from the entrance marks plus the weightage on extracurricular activities (wherever applicable). The merit list for Doctoral programme shall be drawn up on the basis of marks secured in entrance examination only. In case of tie in preparation of merit list, the tie will be resolved by considering the final OGPA / Marks in the following order:
- i) **For Masters' Programme:** Higher entrance mark followed by higher OGPA/percentage of marks in qualifying examination (graduation level), higher percentage of mark in +2 Science/ equivalent (including extra optional) and higher percentage of marks in 10th standard examination (considering all subjects studied, percentage on the basis of best of five or six subject will not be accepted.). If the tie still persists, then candidate, older in age, will be ranked higher.
 - ii) **For Doctoral Programme:** Higher entrance mark followed by higher OGPA/percentage of marks in Masters' level and highest OGPA/percentage of marks in Graduation level and higher percentage of mark in +2 Science/ equivalent (including extra optional). If the tie still persists, then candidate, older in age, will be ranked higher.

NB:

1. **Candidates who do not submit the qualifying examination OGPA/marks with the application within the stipulated time will be ranked lowest in the group of candidates with same weightage (entrance marks+ marks awarded for extracurricular activities).**
2. **The eligibility of the candidate w.r.t. OGPA/Marks as per clause 2.2 of the P.G. Prospectus 2026-27 will be verified at the time of counselling and admission. The ineligible candidates will be denied admission.**

7.4 Entrance Examination

- 7.4.1 **The entrance examination for admission into Masters' programme in Computer Based Test (CBT) mode and for Doctoral programme in offline mode in Bhubaneswar.**
- 7.4.2 **The Entrance Examination will be of 2 hours duration with 200 multiple choice questions of one mark each in English language only. There will be no negative mark for wrong answer.** The multiple choice questions (MCQ) will cover the subjects taught in the Bachelor's Degree level and Masters' Degree (major discipline) for Masters' and Doctoral programme, respectively. The entrance examination will be held in CBT mode for Masters' programme and the entrance examination for doctoral programme (Ph.D.) will be held in off line mode on **18.07.2026** and for M.V.Sc. will be held on **08.11.2026 at Bhubaneswar only.**
- 7.4.3 For M.Sc. (Ag.) course programme, the question of entrance test will be comprised of two parts Part- A and Part-B. There will be 180 general multiple choice questions (Non-crop specific) in part-A and 40 crop specific (Field crop and Horticultural crops in equal proportion) questions in part-B following the common syllabi of Agriculture and Horticulture faculties. Candidates have to attempt all the questions in part-A and any 20 questions from part-B. Based on total marks secured in the entrance test and extracurricular activities, a common merit list will be prepared.

7.4.4 i) ICAR / Departmental candidates sponsored by State Govt./OUAT/Foreign Candidates nominated by ICAR/ICCR/any other statutory bodies of Govt. of India **are exempted from appearing the Entrance Examination**. All other categories of candidates including ICAR Fellowship holders and State Govt. Study Leave candidates are required to appear at Entrance Examination.

ii) The Kashmiri Migrants/ Kashmiri Pandit (Non-Migrants) / Kashmiri Hindu Families (Non-Migrants) living in Kashmir Valley **are not required to appear the OUAT P.G. Entrance Examination - 2026. The interested candidates must apply online, without which admission is not allowed.** The selection of these candidates will be made from a separate merit list prepared on the basis of highest OGPA/percentage of marks in Under Graduate programme for admission into Masters' Programme . Without OGPA/marks of qualifying examinations, the application will be invalid.

In case of a tie, it will be resolved considering the percentage of marks in qualifying examination followed by +2 science and 10th standard in that order.

7.4.5 Mock Test

Link for mock test/practice test (For CBT mode only) will be available on OUAT website from **10.07.2026** for all Masters' programme and from 03.11.2026 for M.V.Sc.

7.4.6 Guideline for online entrance examination in CBT mode for Masters' programme

Basic Instructions:

- The examination will be held in a single sitting.
- **The candidate must appear the entrance examination as per the scheduled time and date mentioned in his/her admit card.**
- The candidates are to report 2 hours before the examination. The detailed instructions will be provided on the admit card.
- Mobile phone / headphone / any other electronic gadgets are not allowed during the examination.
- Candidates found using unfair means shall be debarred from the examination.
- The candidates are to obey instructions of the Centre Superintendent and Invigilators at the Examination Centre.
- The invigilators will take attendance on the attendance sheets in which the candidates shall have to put their **full signature** against their corresponding roll number.
- The candidate has to follow the COVID protocol (if required as per Govt. guidelines and if mentioned on the admit card).
- The candidate after logging in must go through instructions of the examination displayed on the computer screen.
- The examination does not require using any paper, pen, pencil and external calculator. However, paper will be supplied for rough work which will be collected by invigilators.
- Each student will get questions and choice of answers in different order selected randomly from affixed Question Data bank.
- The students just need to click on the Right Choice / Correct option from the multiple choices /options given with each question. For Multiple Choice Questions, each question has four options and the candidate must click the appropriate option.

7.4.7 The sequence of steps to be followed by each examinee for appearing the Examination using Online Examination Portal will be as follows:

- The students will have to enter their application number as Username and DOB (Date of birth as mentioned in application form) as Password and click on “Sign in” button.
- The student’s details will appear on the screen as submitted in Form-A, which must be verified by the student and acknowledge the same by clicking on “I Confirm” button.
- Go through the general instructions and then click on “NEXT” and move to subject specific instructions.
- Once the candidate has gone through the instructions page, the candidate needs to select the language as “English” and click on check box on the left side of declaration.
- The “I am ready to begin” button will be enabled as per the examination scheduled time and the candidate has to click on “I am ready to begin” button to start the examination.
- The student has to proceed answering the questions one by one by clicking on the small grey circle next to the chosen answer.
- The examinee can move to First, Last, Previous, Next and unanswered questions by clicking on the buttons with respective labels displayed on screen throughout the test.
- The answers can be changed at any time during the test and are saved automatically.
- It is possible to review the answered questions as well as the unanswered questions.
- The time remaining is shown in the Right Top Corner of the screen.
- The assessment will get “auto submit” when the time limit is over, OR alternatively, if examinee finishes the exam before time, he can quit by pressing the ‘Submit’ button. **The candidates must not click the “Submit” Button until the candidate wants to quit from the Examination.**
- **However, no candidate can leave the examination hall before completion of the examination.**

7.4.8 **The candidates are to login with their application number and date of birth through the link “Download response sheet of OUAT P.G. Entrance Examination - 2026” in the OUAT website: <https://ouat.ac.in> to view their response sheet with correct answers from 24.07.2026 to 26.07.2026 for all Masters’ Programme in Agriculture and Allied Sciences and from 20.11.2026 to 23.11.2026 for M.V.Sc. (Any change will be notified on OUAT website).**

The candidate can raise a challenge/objection against the questions and answer keys online in the portal paying a non-refundable fee of Rs. 200/- per question as processing charge. Any change in the answer key after objection verification will be notified in OUAT website. The candidate should not send any representation to any mail ids of the University. The detailed procedure will be notified later in OUAT website.

Note :

1. **The weightage on extracurricular activities will be applicable to Masters' admission only.** The candidate can avail extra weightage in above categories stated in clause 7.5 subject to maximum weightage of 2.0 marks. The candidate can avail extra weightage in **only one of the sub-categories** under each of the category mentioned above.
 2. The candidates who claim for direct admission for representing the country at international level for NSS and Sports must submit the application online within the stipulated date.
 3. The candidate has to upload the scanned copy of the documents along with the application and also produce the original documents at the time of counselling.
 4. The uploaded scan copy must be visible properly to verify the documents otherwise no weightage will be awarded.
 5. **The other state candidates will not be eligible for award of weightage on extracurricular activities.**
- 8. ADMISSION PROCEDURE**
- 8.1 **The details of the counselling and admission procedure is as follows.**
- a. The candidates has to report to the counselling and admission as per the date and time mentioned in the intimation-cum-rank card and also in the counselling and admission notice.
 - b. The details of seat matrix to be displayed in the admission hall.
 - c. The admission board will collect the intimation letter-cum-rank card from the candidates.
 - d. The candidate will be called rank-wise to be present before the Admission Board with their original documents for verification.
 - e. Candidates will be asked to choose the course/department from the available seat position displayed in the Counselling Hall through a Final Option Form. Once the option is exercised and admission is confirmed by the Admission Board, no request for change of course/department shall be entertained.
 - f. **However, a candidate admitted to a department through one category of seats can attend counselling and take admission in another department through another category seats if rank in that category has been generated. In such cases, the candidate has to pay the admission fee again and the previously paid admission fee will be refunded deducting processing fees of Rs. 1000/- one month after the admission process is over.**

- g. For refund, the candidate must submit the money receipt of previous payment and bank details in a separate application to Asst. Registrar (Acad.), OUAT, Bhubaneswar.**
- h. Candidate called for counselling and admission are required to produce the following documents in original and two sets of self attested photocopies before Admission Board.

- 8.2 In the event of any change in the scheduled date of counselling and admission, the same will be notified in the notice board of the University and University website for information of the candidates.
- 8.3 A candidate who fails to appear for counselling and admission on the scheduled date, time and place will automatically and irrevocably forfeit his/her claim for admission.
- 8.4 The candidates coming for counselling and admission should bring with them all the original Certificates and Mark sheets / Transcripts for verification. At the time of admission, they have to submit their College Leaving Certificate and Conduct Certificate (if the same is not mentioned in the C.L.C.) in original from the Head of the Institution last attended.
- 8.5 Candidate, who have passed their qualifying examination from a University other than OUAT, will have to submit their Migration Certificate within 3 months, failing which they will not be allowed to appear the final 1st semester examination. Candidates, who have passed their qualifying examination from OUAT and have already been issued migration certificate, must to submit the migration certificate at the time of admission
- 8.6 Candidates who fail to submit their College Leaving Certificate / Conduct Certificate will be provisionally admitted and will be allowed ten working days following the date of admission, on an undertaking for submission of such documents, failing which their provisional admission will be cancelled, if not decided otherwise. Candidate coming from Universities outside the State of Odisha will be allowed fifteen working days following the date of admission for this purpose.
- 8.7 The employees of Govt. or any other Organizations will be admitted into Masters' and Doctoral Courses on submission of "No Objection Certificate" (NOC) from appropriate authority, failing which

they will be denied admission. They will furnish an undertaking in prescribed proforma at **Annexure-VI** to submit their relieve orders within 15 days from the date of admission at the latest, failing which their provisional admission will be cancelled if not decided otherwise.

- 8.8 All candidates selected for admission into Masters' and Doctoral Course Programme shall submit the Medical Fitness Certificate in prescribed form (**Annexure-II**) at the time of admission.
- 8.9 All the admitted candidates need to submit an affidavit, as per the UGC guideline on non indulgence in ragging activities, to their respective Dean within 15 days from the date of admission. The anti ragging declaration also needs to be submitted online in the anti ragging portal.
- 8.9.1 To prohibit any misconduct by any student or students, whether by words spoken or written or by any act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness to a fresher or any other student, or indulging in rowdy or indisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student or asking any student to do any act which such student will not do in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other. Student, with or without any intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student, and thereby, to eliminate ragging in all its forms from University by prohibiting it under these Regulations, preventing its occurrence and punishing those who indulge in ragging as provided for in these Regulations and the appropriate law in force.
- 8.9.2 If a candidate for admission is found to have indulged in ragging and expelled in the past or if it is noticed later that he/she is indulging in ragging, the admission will be cancelled or he/she will be expelled from the University / College.

- 8.10 Candidates shall give an undertaking in the prescribed proforma available at **Annexure-VII at the time of admission to refund the scholarship, fellowship, etc., if he/she has received any from this University in the event of his/her discontinuing study before completion.** However, a student discontinuing his/ her study to take admission in some other Institution will not be required to refund the above amount but the name of the Institution where he/she will continue his/her study will be indicated in the C.L.C.
- 8.11 Spot Admission**
Spot counselling and admission may be considered by the University if any seats of Masters' and Doctoral courses including those of ICAR remain vacant after the scheduled OUAT admission counselling following the procedure given below:
- 8.11.1** Seats that have remained vacant **except over and above seats as mentioned in Clause 4.2** of P.G Prospectus- 2026-27 will be filled up through spot counselling and admission. An advertisement indicating schedule of counselling and admission and vacant seat position will be published in OUAT website. An indicative advertisement will be published in the newspaper.
- 8.11.2 Seats for spot counselling and admission will be filled up from merit/rank list of reserved categories (SC/ST/PwD) and unreserved category. The reserved category seats will be filled up first and if reserved category seats remain vacant, then those seats will be de-reserved and filled up from unreserved merit/rank list. (For Masters' Programme only)

- 8.11.3 **For all vacant seats of different departments/disciplines of M. Sc.(Agriculture) will be filled up as Cost sharing seats if those departments have “Cost Sharing seats”.** During spot counselling and admission, if a seat from the departments where there are cost sharing seats is vacated by an already admitted candidate, then that seat will be treated as cost sharing seat. Rest of the vacant seats across all faculties and departments will be filled up as “general seat”. Any seat (excluding the over and above seats), vacated on cancellation of admission till one day before the spot counselling and admission, will be included for spot admission.
- 8.11.4 Candidates who have been awarded rank in the P.G. counselling and admission Process - 2026 will be eligible to participate in spot counselling and admission. **The candidates belonging to “other state” and “Kashmir migrants/Kashmir Hindu/Kashmir Pandits” category are not eligible to participate.**
- 8.11.5 **The candidates, who have taken admission earlier, are also eligible to participate in the spot counselling admission and can opt for seats of their choice from the vacant seats. (For Masters’ programme only)**
- 8.11.6 The candidates will be called to appear before the admission board according to rank issued earlier. The candidate has to choose one seat from the **vacant seat matrix displayed in the admission hall.** Once a seat is filled up, it will be deleted from the seat matrix on display. Once the candidate exercises his/her option for a seat and admission granted, no request to switch over to another seat will be entertained. **Any candidate, who fails to attend the spot admission physically on scheduled date, will not be considered for admission later.**
- 8.11.7 **If an already admitted Masters’ candidate wants to take admission into another department he/she will pay full admission fee** and the paid admission fee from previous admission will be refunded deducting a processing fee of Rs. 1000/- and the previous admission will stand cancelled. No request for adjustment of fee paid earlier will be considered.
- 8.11.8 **The over and above seats under NRI/PIO and Other state quota are not included for spot admission. No refund of admission fee will be made on cancellation of those seats (Clause 17 of P.G Prospectus-2026-27.).** If a candidate has already taken admission in NRI/PIO seats and takes admission again in spot counselling and admission, the admission fee from the previous admission in NRI/PIO seat will not be refunded.
- 8.11.9 **An admitted candidate must produce the admission letter issued from the previous admission process before the admission board.**
- 8.11.10 In case a seat is vacant during spot counselling by an already admitted candidate, who takes admission in another course/department, the seat will be shown on the vacant seat matrix on display in the admission hall and it will be available to the next candidate on merit for admission. The candidate, who has been admitted prior to the seat being vacant can not claim the seat on the plea that he/she has higher rank. The candidate will have to choose a seat from the available seats on display in the admission hall when he/she is called to appear before the admission board for admission according to his/her rank.

9. ACADEMIC SYSTEM

9.1 Duration of Courses

- 9.1.1 A Masters’ Degree Programme is a full-time study of two years which includes both course work and research for thesis. The maximum permissible period for completion of a Masters’ degree is five consecutive academic years for direct students and six consecutive years for in- service students.
- 9.1.2 A Doctoral Programme is a full-time study of three years which includes both course work and research for thesis. The maximum permissible period for completion of the course is seven consecutive academic years for direct students and eight consecutive years for in-service students.

9.1.3 An academic year consists of two semesters each having minimum duration of 110 working days consisting of 95 Net Instructional Day (NID) and 15 examination days.

9.2 Course Programme, Instruction and Evaluation

9.2.1 The Instruction is offered in English under course-credit system. Each course is divided into distinct course units of major or core and supporting or minor courses. Each student admitted into a course programme shall take courses as per the plan of course programme suggested by the student advisory committee.

9.2.2 The performance of the students for each course unit shall be evaluated in terms of assignment, mid-term, theory / practical examination, and final theory and / or practical examination on a 10-point scale. All students admitted into Masters' or Ph.D. course programme shall submit thesis after completion of course programme as per rules and regulations.

9.2.3 A student is required to have a minimum of 85% of attendance in each course, failing which he/she shall not be allowed to appear at the Final Examination and will be detained in that semester, subject to regulation of condonation as indicated below.

The Dean, on the recommendation of the course teacher/ advisor concerned may condone shortage of attendance up to 15% in each course on valid ground to his satisfaction and allow such students to appear at the Final Examination on payment of the required fees (Clause 3.6.4 of Semester Regulation for Masters' & Doctoral Programme). No condonation, even on medical ground can be granted for shortage of attendance below 70% under any circumstances. Discontinuance of degree programme will be guided by the Semester Regulation for Masters' Programme.

9.2.4 Maximum period of 5 years for Masters' and 7 years for Ph.D. programme are allowed to the regular candidates to complete the degree Programme & Doctoral Programme respectively.

9.2.5 The candidate has to pay the entire semester fee (mentioned at 13 C) during the extended semesters.

NB: The student admitted into any of the Masters' or Doctoral Programme shall be guided by the P.G. Semester Regulation, 2023 or any modifications incorporated time to time.

10. HOSTEL AND MEDICAL FACILITIES

10.1 Hostel accommodation shall be provided to all Masters' and Ph.D. students on merit basis subject to availability of seats. After admission, the students shall apply to the Dean, Students' Welfare (DSW) through the concerned Dean of the college for their stay in a hostel. However, a student whose parents are staying at Bhubaneswar may be allowed by the DSW to stay outside the hostel during the course of his/her study. But in the case of foreign students, no such permission will be granted. The students desirous to stay outside the hostel shall obtain a Day Scholar Certificate from the Dean, Students' Welfare.

10.2 The University runs a Wellness Centre manned by experienced doctors and it provides outdoor treatment to students of the University.

11. STUDENT ACTIVITIES

11.1 The students' union comprising of students' representatives is formed every year at each College level to organize cultural / athletic / sport & activities. The students are also allowed to participate in various inter-college and inter-university competitions at state and national level to show their talent in extracurricular activities.

11.2 **Students' Welfare:** The Dean of Students' Welfare Division looks after the accommodation and extracurricular activities of the students. The University Employment Information and Guidance Bureau acts as a useful channel of communication between the students and employment organizations.

12. STUDENT DISCIPLINE

A student, whether a boarder or day scholar, shall abide by the disciplinary rules and regulations of the Hostel, College and University and shall not involve himself / herself in any objectionable conduct such as violation of hostel discipline, disobedience of instructions of hostel authorities, immoral conduct or disorderly behavior including "ragging". In case a student is found to be involved in any of the said undesirable activities, he/she shall be liable for expulsion from the hostel and if the offence is grave in nature, also from the college. The expulsion from the hostel shall be ordered by the Dean of Students' Welfare with the concurrence of the Dean of the Faculty concerned and expulsion from the college shall be by the orders of the Vice-Chancellor. The students and the parents have to submit affidavits in this regard as per **Annexure VIII & IX**.

However, there will be no refund of fee except caution money against cancellation of admission of over and above seats (NRI/PIO sponsored /KM/KP or KH /Other state seat/Govt. in-service candidates).**
- **Any admitted candidate, if switches over to another department during counselling and admission as per clause 8.1 (f) the fees will be refunded deducting processing fee of Rs. 1000/-**
- **No refund of admission fee except the caution money for cancellation of seat will be paid after the spot admission process is over.**
- Caution money shall be refunded to the discontinued or passed out students after adjustment of dues, if any.
- In case a student is promoted to next Semester on Scholastic Probation but becomes unsuccessful in Special Examination and is detained, the entire fees deposited for admission into the higher semester/year shall be refunded to the student upon his/ her application. Else the fees will be adjusted if he candidate seeks admission for the same year in next academic year.
